Years 9 and up are **not** eligible.

Online Applications need to be completed before the closing date.

Late Applications will not be accepted.

ALL applicants MUST have ATTAINED at least Grade 6 or higher (refer to 'Ara Music Awards Competition Information' document).

Proof of Highest Music Exam grade passed, Trinity or Royals Schools etc.

ON WHAT INSTRUMENT(S) WILL YOU BE PEROFRMING AT THIS COMPETITION

Piano, Violin, Cello, Viola, Harp

Applicants may enter in one or two instruments. eg Piano & Violin or Piano & Cello etc but, must submit a separate application for each one.

Length playing that instrument in years & months

Music Teacher Details, Name of Instrument Teacher & Phone number

Please note that accompanists are not provided.

HOWEVER if there is a difficulty in finding an accompanist, please contact the Co-ordinator to help arrange for a substitute accompanist (at your cost). Contact details are at the end of this form.
